

# Join the Urban League to “MASK WHAT MATTERS”

The Knox County Board of Health Passed a face mask mandate Wednesday, July 1st!

This health order is requiring most people to wear face coverings in public to help slow the spread of COVID-19. People should wear face masks while they are within 6 feet of others in public indoor spaces in Knox County.

The order goes into effect Friday July 3<sup>rd</sup> and lasts until the board votes to rescind it.

*(Excluded are places of worship as well as state and federal government facilities. Children under 12 will not be required to wear masks, and neither will people who have medical conditions that prevent them from wearing one.)*

The CDC advises the use of simple cloth face coverings to slow the spread of the virus and help people who may have the virus and do not know it from transmitting it to others.
